



## Yurt Pet Policy

We love animals! While many destinations do not accept furry visitors, we do our best to welcome pets. Guests who travel with their pets have been found, almost without exception, to be considerate and responsible for their companions. Dogs are welcome in our yurts when accompanied by their responsible owners.

We also love people! In order for everyone to get along and enjoy this beautiful place, it's important to respect our pet policies. The following rules help us continue to welcome pets of yurt guests at Merridale:

- Pets are to be kept off all furniture.
- Pets must sleep on the floor or in their travel kennels.
- Pets must not be left unattended at any time and must be kept on a leash during walks or while sitting at the picnic tables in our courtyard. You and your pet must stick to the paths around the property, especially in the orchard where the apple trees are vulnerable to disturbances.
- During your time in the farmhouse, you must tie up your pet in our designated "four-legged" area outside, called the Hitching Post.
- Pets may not be destructive to our facilities or aggressive with animals or people. Damage that occurs due to your pet must be charged accordingly.
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up and scooping up after their pets.
- Our Merridale dogs live here too. Please keep your dog on a leash at all times.

If your pet can conduct themselves as noted above, they are a welcome Merridale guest!

**Our pet fee is \$35.00 per stay.**
